The museum is in a large red brick building.



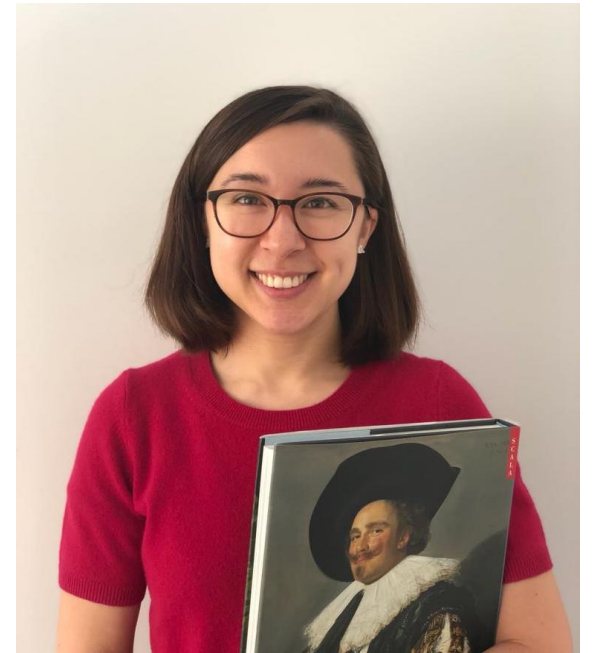
Inside the front entrance you will find some large glass doors.



Through the glass doors, you can see a grand staircase.



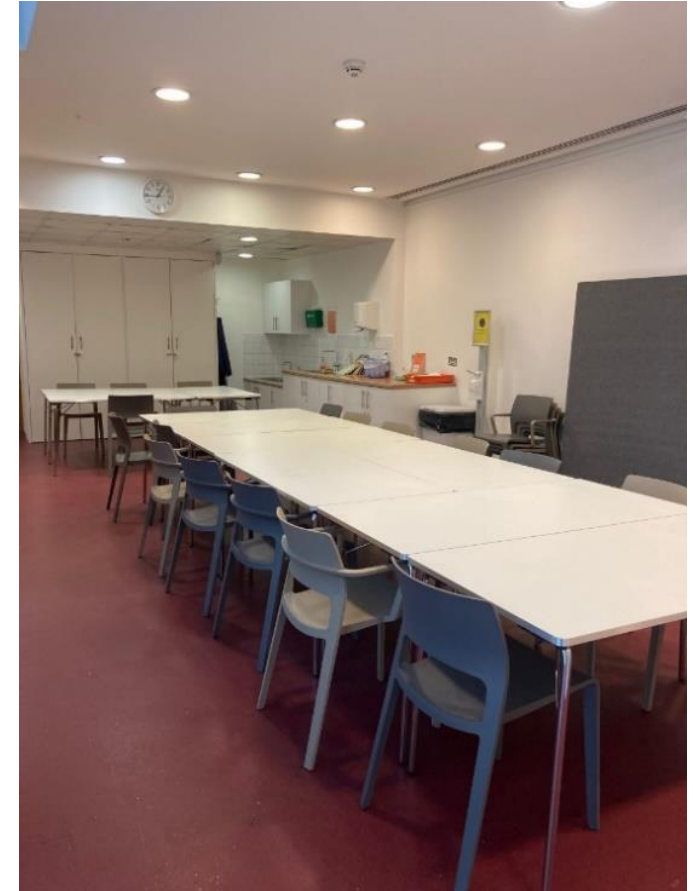
While at the Wallace Collection, you will meet friendly museum staff members and artists. Together we will go downstairs to the Learning Studio.
